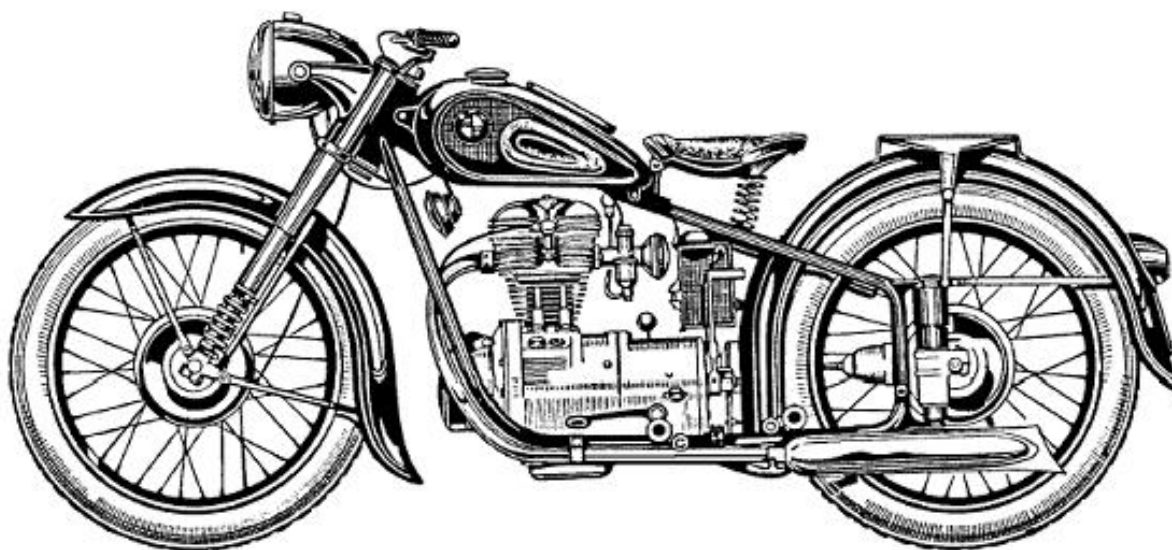


Old Bikes at the Fort
